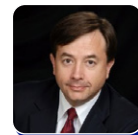

OUR HISTORY



- In the midst of the malaise that enveloped Memphis following the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Lucius E. Burch Jr., a prominent Memphis attorney, foresaw a city that could produce a new generation of leaders to usher in a new attitude and honesty about race relations but also lead the city toward a brighter future. Following the lead of neighboring cities Nashville and Memphis, Burch was committed to founding an organization that brought diverse leaders together around a shared agenda of a healthy, thriving Memphis.
- Burch called on Junior League President Kate Gooch and attorney Lewis Donelson to drive the conversation about a leadership organization, founded as The Memphis Institute of Public Responsibility – and what is now Leadership Memphis.
- As we look ahead to 50 years, we are re-forging our roots, and reigniting leaders across sectors towards investments of their time, talent, treasure, and ties in support of a greater Memphis.

FAST TRACK

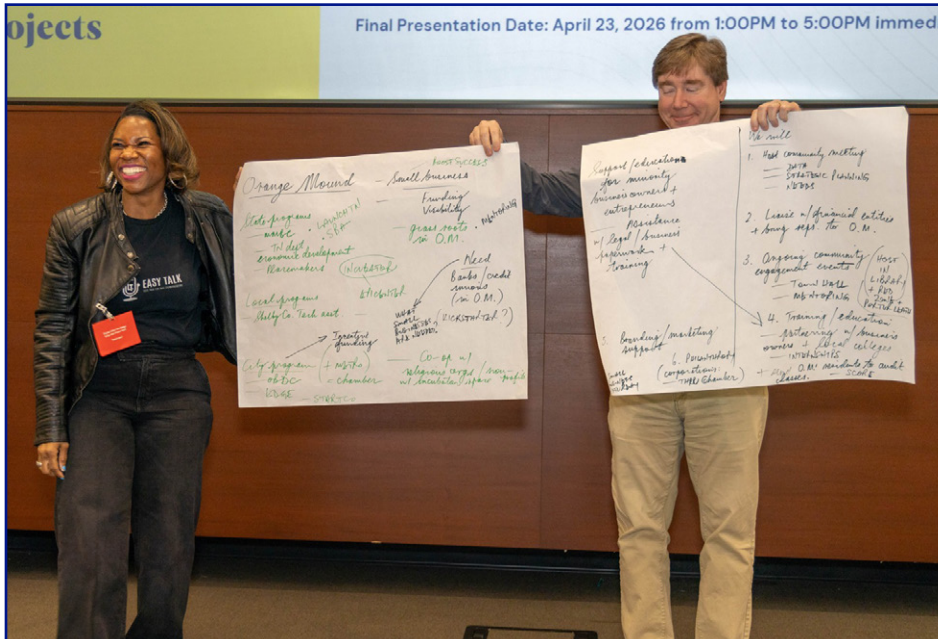

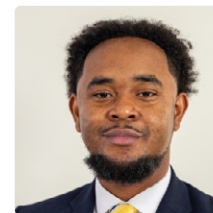
